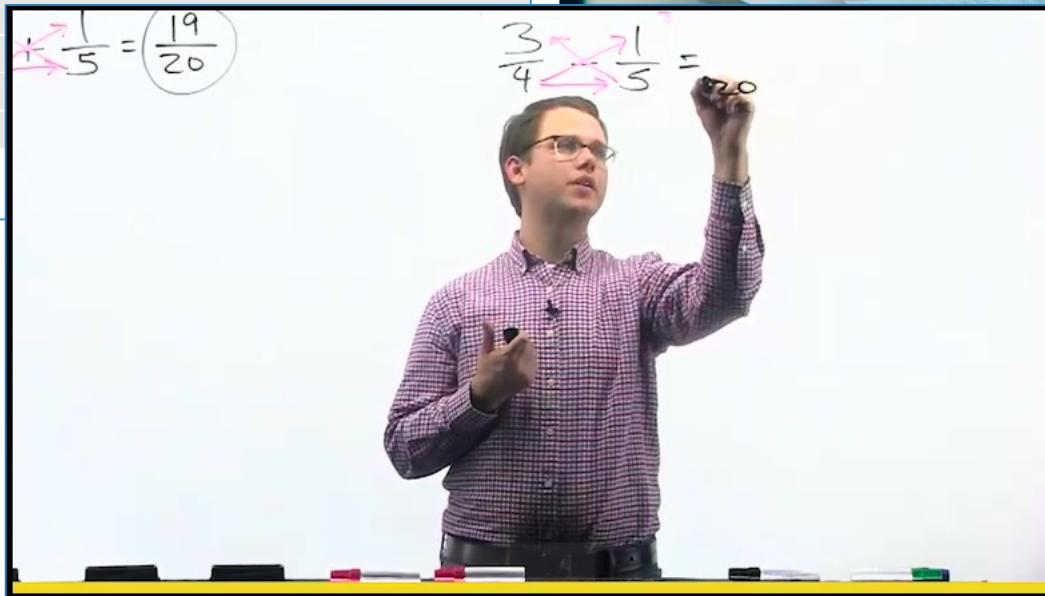

In terms of content and organization, there are some things that need to be worked on. First of all, I think that you need to make a stronger argument other than these works being the best representations of this topic. That clearly states an opinion, but you should also mention the evidence that supports this. Show the reader why these are the best, rather than just telling them. And since "the best" is something that means different things to different people, try to define in a more descriptive way what you consider "the best" to mean. Also, I would suggest focusing on more ways they portray longing instead of just making the reader feel the desire for the subject as well. That is fine to mention as one point of evidence, but the argument would be strengthened if you were to refer to other ways that the longing is portrayed. Was there a particular way these authors wrote that depicted longing well? Does addressing this in a positive or negative way make these "the best" representations? I will leave a link below to help you with the Chicago style citations.

For the punctuation errors, I will provide an informative link below that goes over multiple forms of punctuation and also one that you can use when citing your sources.
