## **DoD Expands Tutor.com for U.S. Military Families™ Eligibility**

Effective April 13, 2020, thanks to additional funding from the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD), tutoring and homework help from Tutor for U.S. Military Families™ (Tutor.com/military) is now available at no cost to all U.S. military service members, DoD personnel, and their dependents. The Tutor.com/military program provides 24/7 online tutoring in more than 100 academic subjects for grades kindergarten through college.

DoD Military Community and Family Policy (MC&FP) has temporarily expanded eligibility for the Tutor.com/military program to support DoD-affiliated personnel and their families who are being impacted by COVID-19 disruptions. With the expanded eligibility, all Active Duty, National Guard, Reserve, and Wounded Warrior service members; DoD civilian personnel; and their dependent children and spouses are eligible to access Tutor.com/military at no cost. Survivors of KIA service members plus ROTC, NROTC, and DoD Service Academy cadets are also now eligible to use the program.

Eligible military-connected students can access online tutoring from any internet-connected device on-demand 24/7. Once connected, a student and tutor work together anonymously in a secure online classroom, communicating in real-time using text or voice chat, an interactive whiteboard, file sharing, and more.

The DoD has funded access to Tutor.com/military for grades K-12 children of active duty service members since 2008. These children continue to remain eligible. There are no changes to access and eligibility for U.S. Coast Guard families funded by Coast Guard Mutual Assistance.
