endanger	danger	en-	to make in danger
midday	<u>day</u>	mid-	in the middle of the day
misadventure	<u>adventure</u>	mis-	a bad adventure
multicultural	<u>cultural</u>	multi-	related to more than one culture
musicology	music	-ology	the study of music
nonabsorbent	<u>absorb</u>	non-, -ent	not able to absorb
overreact	react	over-	reacting too much
reliable	<u>rely</u>	-able	-able to be relied on
senseless	<u>sense</u>	- <u>less</u>	without sense or senses
